

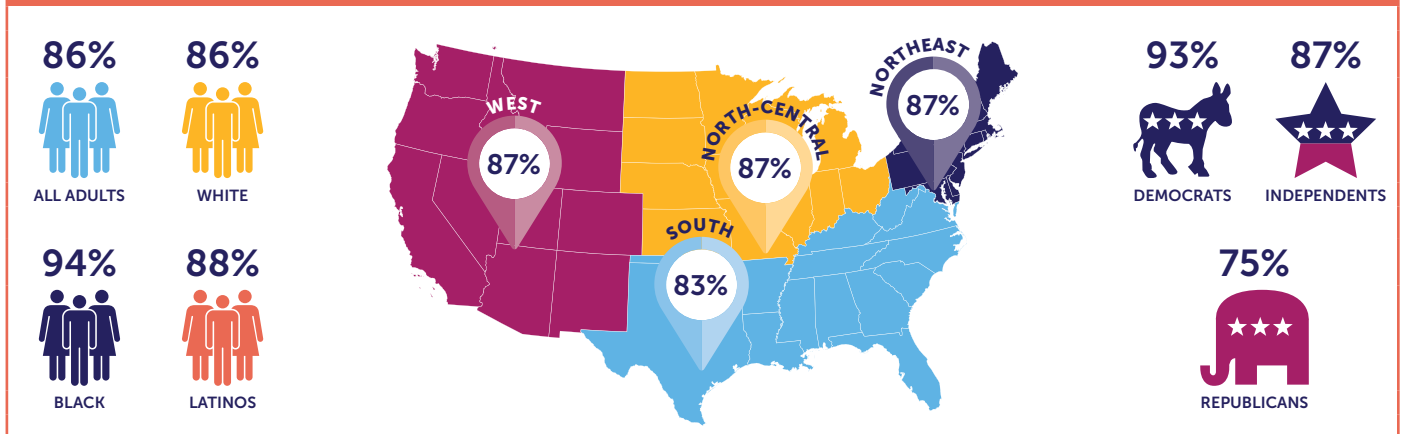

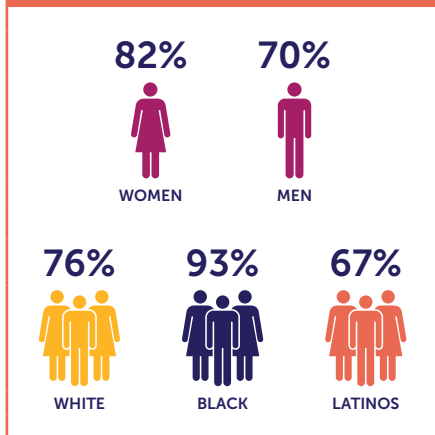

New public opinion polling commissioned by Power to Decide shows overwhelming support for birth control

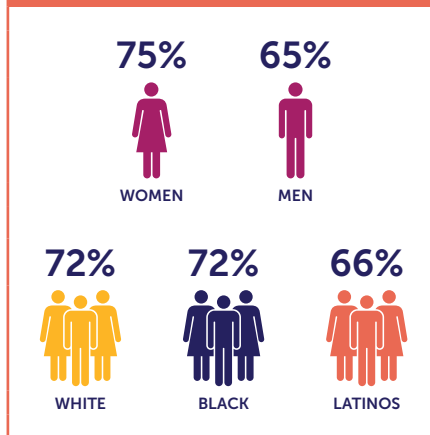
THE MAJORITY OF ADULTS—REGARDLESS OF RACE/ETHNICITY, REGION, AND POLITICAL AFFILIATION—SUPPORT ACCESS TO ALL METHODS OF CONTRACEPTION



76% OF ADULTS IN THE US BELIEVE THAT BIRTH CONTROL SHOULD BE CONSIDERED A BASIC PART OF WOMEN'S HEALTH CARE



70% OF ALL ADULTS AGREE WITH THE STATEMENT: BIRTH CONTROL ALLOWED ME OR MY PARTNER TO DECIDE IF OR WHEN TO HAVE A CHILD



THE MAJORITY OF ADULTS AGREE THAT THE CURRENT POLITICAL LANDSCAPE THREATENS PEOPLE'S ACCESS TO CONTRACEPTION



The telephone survey was conducted for Power to Decide by SSRS, an independent research company. Fully 1,004 interviews were conducted between September 17, 2019 and September 22, 2019 among the general population (age 18 and older). The margin of error for total respondents is +/-3.35% at the 95% confidence level.
