

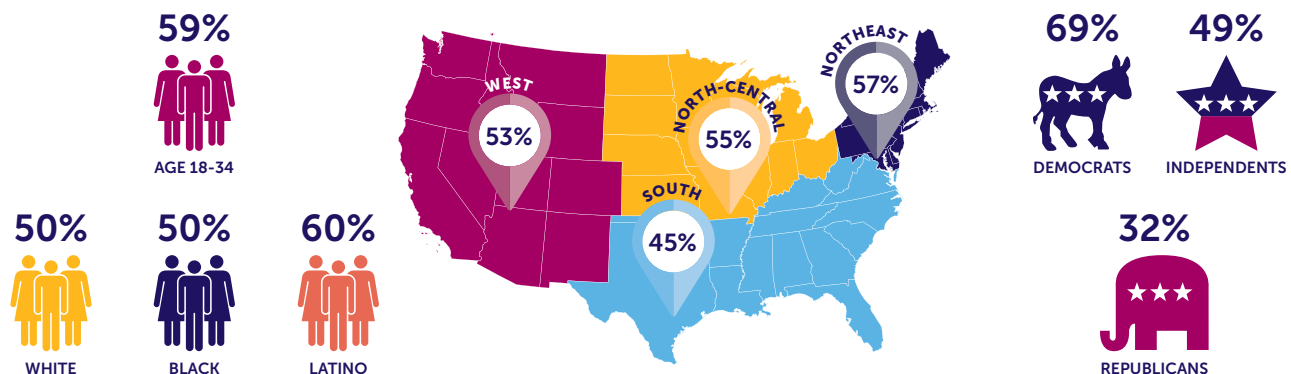
# SURVEY SAYS

POWER TO DECIDE, THE CAMPAIGN TO PREVENT UNPLANNED PREGNANCY

## THANKS, BIRTH CONTROL

New public opinion polling commissioned by Power to Decide shows concerns about access to contraception.

**51%** OF ADULTS (18 AND OLDER) ARE CONCERNED ABOUT THE ABILITY OF THE GENERAL PUBLIC TO AFFORD OR ACCESS CONTRACEPTION GIVEN THE SHIFT IN THE SUPREME COURT



**84%**

OF ADULTS ARE THANKFUL THAT BIRTH CONTROL ALLOWS THEM TO DECIDE IF, WHEN, AND UNDER WHAT CIRCUMSTANCES TO GET PREGNANT AND HAVE A CHILD



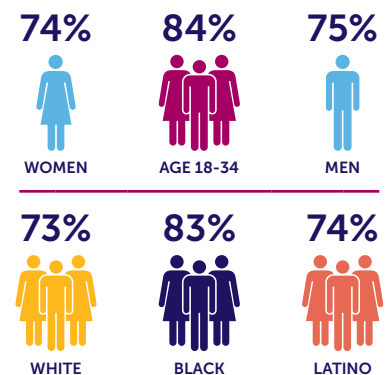
**72%**

OF ADULTS ARE THANKFUL THAT BIRTH CONTROL ALLOWS THEM TO MANAGE SEVERAL HEALTH CONDITIONS



**74%**

OF ADULTS APPRECIATE BIRTH CONTROL FOR THE ABILITY TO WORK TOWARD EDUCATIONAL OR PROFESSIONAL GOALS



The telephone survey was conducted for Power to Decide by SSRS, an independent research company. A total of 1,004 interviews were conducted between September 29, 2020 and October 4, 2020, among the general population (age 18 and older). The margin of error for total respondents is +/-3.58% at the 95% confidence level.
