NEARLY 7 IN 10 (69%) UP FROM 51% IN 2020

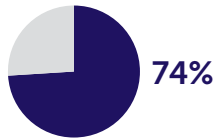


MOST SUPPORT ACCESS TO ALL METHODS OF BIRTH CONTROL REGARDLESS OF PARTY AFFILIATION.



IN 2021, MOST PEOPLE USED SOME FORM OF CONTRACEPTION TO AVOID AN UNPLANNED PREGNANCY.

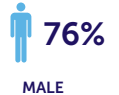

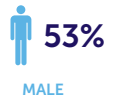
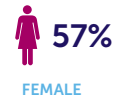

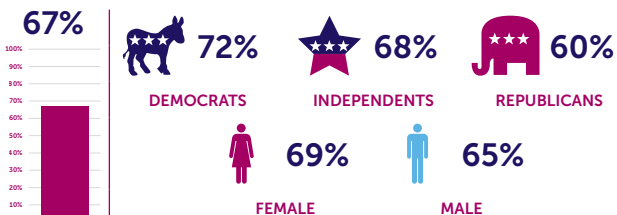

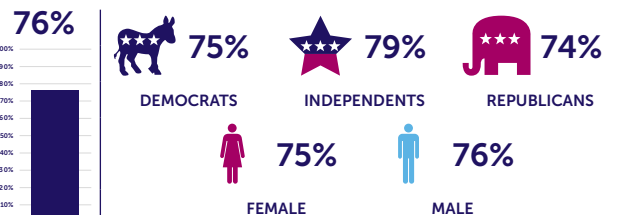
BIRTH CONTROL HELPS PEOPLE WORK TOWARDS EDUCATIONAL AND PROFESSIONAL GOALS.

The study was conducted for Power to Decide via telephone by SSRS, an independent research company. Interviews were conducted on September 21, 2021 – October 7, 2021 among adults ages 18 to 45. A total of 1,005 interviews were conducted, with a margin of error for total respondents of +/-3.95% adjusted for design effect, at the 95% confidence level
