SUPPORTING COMMUNITIES THROUGH REPRODUCTIVE WELL-BEING

To build a system of support for reproductive well-being in communities across the country, Power to Decide is convening a Shared Learning Collaborative of up to 10 place-based teams. These teams will be cross-sectoral (e.g., public health, education, economic development, social services, etc.) and include youth representation.

SLC TEAM EXPECTATIONS:

- Core team of 4 members (including youth ambassador) will lead the place-based initiative throughout the funding period with support from Power to Decide
- Be actively engaged in an existing cross-sectoral coalition or initiative that supports sexual and reproductive health
- Attend and participate in two in-person convenings annually
- Participate in monthly virtual check-ins with Power to Decide staff
- Complete an annual reproductive well-being assessment
- Complete quarterly progress reports

YOUTH AMBASSADOR EXPECTATIONS:

- Between the ages of 18 and 25
- In good academic standing (if attending school)
- Attend two in-person convenings per year
- Attend monthly virtual SLC team check-ins with Power to Decide staff
- Actively engage with their SLC team to strategize and complete activities related to the initiative



AWARD INFORMATION:

- Successful teams will receive up to \$20,000 over the three-year funding period (to be disbursed to the lead organization in years two and three) to support expenses associated with building reproductive well-being in their community
- Each Youth Ambassador will receive a \$3,000 stipend (\$1,000/year)
- Separately, Power to Decide will support travel costs for all core team members to attend two in-person convenings annually in Washington, D.C. over the three-year funding period
