- ^ A three-year extension of funding for these mandatory funding streams was attached to a bipartisan, bicameral appropriations deal to fund the government through the rest of FY2021.
- * President Biden's FY 2024 budget proposal included a one-year extension of PREP. It did not include an extension of Title V SRAE.
- # All three continuing resolutions passed by Congress (P.L. 118-15, P.L. 118-22, P.L. 118-35) to temporarily fund discretionary government operations also contained short-term funding extensions of PREP and Title V SRAE.
