Power to Decide, the campaign to prevent unplanned pregnancy, believes that all young people should have the opportunity to pursue the future they want, realize their full possibility, and follow their intentions. These beliefs guide our work to ensure that all young people have the power to decide if, when, and under what circumstances to get pregnant. We provide objective, evidence-based information about sexual health and contraceptive options, and we work to guarantee equitable access to and information about the full range of contraceptive methods. We are a national, non-partisan organization that is committed to common ground, common sense solutions and catalyzing innovation in the public and private sectors.

Position

The Director, Health Care is a new role, focused on positioning Power to Decide as the go-to resource for sexual health, contraceptive care, and preconception planning for health care and social service providers working with people of reproductive age. The Director, Health Care will build strategic partnerships with health care systems, payers, and health and social service providers across the country to expand the reach of Power to Decide's key resources, including Bedsider and One Key Question®. The Director will build and execute a strategy to scale efforts to improve reproductive health care, that will include but not be limited to creating and enhancing patient and provider resources, delivering trainings, building a system of support for providers, and creating opportunities to connect with and learn from each other. This position offers an exciting opportunity to make a meaningful difference in people's lives by supporting sexual and reproductive health. The Director, Health Care will report to the Senior Director, Digital Programs and Education.

Responsibilities

Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Creating and fostering relationships and partnerships with health care systems, payers, and providers nationally to leverage Power to Decide assets, such as Bedsider and One Key Question®, for providers and patients.
- Developing, delivering, and evaluating in-person and remote trainings for providers on Power to Decide assets for providers and patients and how they can be incorporated into their practice.
- Managing the provider-focused content on the Power to Decide website, including creating content, recruiting and managing freelance health care professionals to create and vet content, and identifying and posting resources to enhance the sites
- Providing leadership on ensuring the accuracy and timeliness of health-related content geared toward consumer audiences on PowertoDecide.org and Bedsider.org.

- Representing and promoting the organization at conferences, with professional organizations, and as a media spokesperson around medical issues.
- Serving as the medical advisor to all Power to Decide efforts.

Qualifications

We are looking for someone who will think big, embrace innovation, and seek new ways of addressing issues. S/he will be collaborative and proactive; value diversity of thought, backgrounds, and perspectives; be responsible, conscientious, adaptive, and resourceful. S/he will be able to comfortably embrace a non-ideological “big tent” approach to sexual health and unplanned pregnancy prevention and be passionate about creating a culture in which all young people can thrive.

- Excellent communication skills, including public speaking and strong writing and editing abilities
- At least have 8-to-10 years of relevant work experience.
